Trial Proposal Status:

DEFUSE 3 Closeout – Greg Albers

Dr. Albers communicated that they have finished the final FDA report. There are currently 10 sub-studies in process, with two having been submitted (Marks and Lansberg). They are working with the DAWN trial on a HERMES like analysis.

Telerehabilitation in Patients with Stroke Closeout – Joe Broderick for Steve Cramer

Dr. Broderick reported that the study continues to collect the equipment from sites and work on closing out the study. The goal is to present results at the ESOC in May, if they can finalize the data in time for that meeting. Dr. Broderick thanked everyone for their work on the trial.

o MOST update – Ope Adeoye

Dr. Adeoye said that preparations continue with the NCC and NDMC. Once they have an award, they can begin the contracting process. The goal for first enrollment is fall. The DSMB meeting is 22-March.

Sleep Smart update – Devin Brown

Dr. Brown reported that the CIRB was reviewing their submission today. They are being reviewed by the DSMB next Thursday, along with MOST. Dr. Brown indicated that they are finalizing their sites, and if a site has enthusiasm for the study, coordinator availability and a respiratory therapist, they should contact her as soon as possible.

TRANSPORT 2 update – Wayne Feng/Gottfried Schlaug

Dr. Schlaug reported that they are finalizing their sites, as well. They have identified 15 sites who have enthusiasm and the required equipment (equipment is not supplied, so sites must already have it), however, they will email the RCCs to see if there are other sites who would qualify and are interested. Their budget has been reduced to nine sites, so this will require their attention.

A total of 18 subjects have been consented in the trial. Two subjects have been randomized and 4 more subjects are "eligible for randomization" so hopefully our numbers will be increasing very soon.

We are excited to see the trial moving forward and ask that you encourage your sites to continue working on their study start-up documents.

RCCs will need to submit a Final-RPPR (Progress Report) no later than 120 calendar days *after* the period of performance end date (which is 7/31/2018). Earlier in the window is preferred for centers that will receive an award as an RCC for the 2nd cycle of NIH StrokeNet. Your Sponsored Research Office will work with you to complete the RPPR. Therefore, the options provided on the forms for answers to the questions (such as yes or no) are the only choices that can be entered. When the form is modified by someone other than the CIRB, the answer options can have a great impact on completion in the electronic system, as well as the intent of the question and how it is viewed by anyone reviewing, monitoring, or auditing the site's information provided to the CIRB.
