- **MOST**

Many sites have completed their Clinical Trial Agreements and are working on the CIRB packages. A few of these sites have already received CIRB approval. There is a bit of delay in drug shipment due to manufacturing. The investigator meeting is scheduled for May 6, 2019 in Philadelphia (PA). Target for first enrollment End of May.

- **SLEEP SMART**

SLEEP SMART Investigator Meeting was held on February 22<sup>nd</sup> in Detroit (MI). **A special thank you to Alexian Brothers for finding the UW team among the many investigators! It was lovely meeting you!** This study has two types of agreements – the PTA with Sleep Smart and a Data Use Agreement/Equipment with Fusion Health, company providing equipment for the study. 17 sites selected – CIRB packets were sent out. Investigator meeting was held last week. Target for first enrollment mid-April.
- **IACQUIRE**  
Notice of award received. 12 sites participating, total of 240 subjects to be enrolled. Selection of sites if being finalized. IM meeting will be held May 1<sup>st</sup> at the Hilton Chicago O’Hare Airport Hotel.
- **ASPIRE**  
Study approved for funding and currently waiting to receive the Notice of Award from NIH/NINDS.
- **FASTEST and ancillary study ACADIA-CSI**  
Both studies have been approved for funding as of this week.

### DEFUSE 3: Distinguished Clinical Research Achievement Award

On behalf of the entire StrokeNet community, congratulations to **Dr. Greg Albers** and the DEFUSE 3 team! DEFUSE 3, a StrokeNet study, was awarded the **Distinguished Clinical Research Achievement Award** on March 5, 2019. Distinguished Clinical Research Achievement Awards are presented to the top two studies that show creativity, innovation, or a novel approach that demonstrates an immediate impact on the health and well-being of patients. Among all clinical trials performed last year, *in all areas of medicine*, DEFUSE 3 was recognized for its contribution to stroke research.

On March 6, Dr. Albers presented the results of the DEFUSE 3 study to members of Congress and discussed the critical role of federal funding for clinical research.

The NIH StrokeNet is honored to list DEFUSE 3 as an example of the cutting edge research associated with this network.
